

**Regular Town Board Meeting Minutes**  
**Tuesday, November 11, 2025**  
**Community Center, 5:00 p.m.**

Chairman Cushing called the meeting to order and noted that it was posted, published, and handicapped accessible in accordance with Wisconsin Open Meeting Laws. A moment of silence was observed to honor our troops here and abroad. Pledge of Allegiance was spoken.

Present: Chairman Cushing, Supervisor Fuhrman, Supervisor Verdoorn, Treasurer Murdoff, and Clerk Myshchysyn.

Motion by Verdoorn, second by Fuhrman to approve the agenda as read. Motion carried.

Motion by Fuhrman, second by Verdoorn to approve the minutes from October 14, 2025, regular board meeting minutes as posted. Motion carried.

Motion by Fuhrman, second by Verdoorn to approve the Treasurer's report as read. Motion carried.

Messages/Announcements/Correspondence/Bid Submissions: Building permits were reviewed. Clerk Myshchysyn received a message from a landowner who inquired about buying some town property that is adjacent to their property. The board directed the clerk to add this item to the December board agenda.

Public Input – taken during the meeting.

1. Town crew maintenance report – Scott Pockat – Wildwood Drive road project is complete. Most of the leaves have been cleaned up at the cemeteries, but weather put a stop to finishing it. Sander and plows are on and ready for winter. Repairs to the hydraulic pump on truck #4 and the ram on truck # 1 have been completed. The DOT is requiring road signs to be nine inches with 6-inch lettering. With sales of some of the old road signs, the crew has replaced all the signs on Hwy 51. Cracksealing was completed and turned out well. Supervisor Fuhrman advised the crew to put the gates up at the cemeteries and Pockat indicated that it is scheduled to be finished soon.

Motion by Verdoorn, second by Fuhrman to approve a Conditional Use Permit application by Tuscanny Bellman, applicant, Travis and Tracy Bellman, owners, to operate an equine business involving, horse training, riding lessons and boarding on the following described property: Lot 3, CSM 5601, being part of the SW-NW, Section 6, T38N, R6E, PIN HA-56, 10849 Lower Kaubashine Road, Town of Hazelhurst. Motion carried.
4. The Town's Christmas Party is scheduled for Saturday, December 20<sup>th</sup> most likely at the Community Center.
5. Motion by Verdoorn, second by Cushing to approve submitting to the DNR condition reports and potential wake boat ordinance for Lake Katherine in the Town of Hazelhurst. Motion carried.
6. Motion by Verdoorn, second by Fuhrman to approve the payment of bills. Motion carried.
